This Sunday we will be looking at the story of the Wise Men. The question I want to ask is what were they really searching for? It says they asked for the one who was born king of the Jews. Why would they want to know about a baby born in a distant country, 1,500 km away? By the time this baby grew up to be an adult they would probably have passed away. Even if he did become a king, it was going to be in a little obscure Roman province that surely will have no influence on where they lived. How could this little baby's birth have any impact on their lives? Yet they put together what would have been a large entourage of people at great expense and travelled for 4 months into a distant land in search of this baby. What were they really looking for? People might say today, how can a baby born 2000 years ago in a distant land have any impact on us today? That is the miracle of Christmas.

Today people everywhere are searching. They may not be searching for a baby, but without even realising it they are searching for what this baby offers us. Isaiah 9:6-7 tells us what this baby going to bring to the world; "For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the greatness of his government and peace there will be no end. He will reign on David's throne and over his kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever". He's going to bring an everlasting peace, righteousness and justice. This is what our world is looking for and I suspect this is what the Wise Men were looking for. They may have even read the prophecies about the Messiah and were desperate to find Him. Are you searching? What are you looking for? The story of the Wise Men takes us on a journey of discovery as we follow their search to find truth and hope. It led to a baby born in a distant land in a small

Roman province. Join us on Sunday as we follow the Wise Men and see how they went about their search. In the end they would find that the Saviour of the World came in the most unlikely way, in the most unlikely place at the most unlikely time, BUT He came. He said "I am the way the truth and the life, no one comes to the Father
