As we share in walking the path that Jesus walked in the lead-up to Easter, we're discovering events where the power of Jesus and His heart for His people are on full display.

This Good Shepherd proves Himself over and over to be the hope of the hopeless, the restorer of the marginalised and the lover of the unlovely.

This week we'll look at the woman who had bleeding for 12 years and the impact that by putting her faith in Jesus had on her life.

At the core of this event is a woman who has lost almost everything.

She's sick, she's financially destitute and she's a social outcast.

She's tried every piece of human advice that's been offered, and it's got her no where.

This is the sort of situation that Jesus steps into. All he asks is that we place our faith in Him so that he can deliver the peace he promises.

In this case, the woman takes that bold step of approaching Jesus and receives physical healing. But Jesus focuses less on that and more on relationship and ongoing victory as he speaks to her. In front of a pressing crowd, He makes a clear statement that this woman, who the world has rejected, is valuable and precious in his sight. Maybe you feel as though your situation is hopeless, or you feel rejected by the world.

Jesus is calling you to fix your eyes on Him and to make a direct connection.

The woman with bleeding had to overcome a lot of obstacles to get to Jesus - which we'll unpack in the message.

Maybe you feel you're facing a similar battle. Jesus says "come". Push through the battles, the fear, the awkwardness, and tell Him your story.

His promise is peace, and it's not in short supply.
